SSL locks all critical information passed from you to us, such as payment information, in an encrypted envelope, making it extremely difficult for this information to be intercepted. We then send this information via the same method to the PayFlow gateway for processing. Catapult Smallprint does not retain Credit Card details, these details are held on PayFlow/PayPal's systems.
